## Prepare Cameras

Check batteries. Charge video camera. Buy film or video cards. Get Birthday Message Cameras for the kids to use.

Remove breakable items and objects that could prevent guests from moving freely. Decorate with balloons, crepe paper, and other items included in your party pack.Set Up Party Games, Fill Favor Boxes \& Piñatas Invite your party child to help!
Party Day!
Fill Birthday Balloons with Helium Waiting till party day ensures they float well. Gather in bunches, and attach to your front door and the birthday child's chair with curling ribbon.

## Curly Bill Cactus Mural

Estimated time: 10 minutes for each child. Estimated cost for a party of 8: $\$ 10$.
Supplies:

- wide sheet of butcher paper and tape
- boxes of jumbo crayons

Few kids will resist a chance to draw on the wall. But don't worry-you won't have to repaint the room! Just tape a wide sheet of butcher paper on the lower portion of your wall so kids can reach. And provide jumbo crayons, for your budding mural artists. (This is a perfect activity to keep kids—and adult helpers-entertained while other guests are still arriving.)

## Charley's Hidden Horse Friends

Estimated time: 25 minutes. Estimated cost for a party of 8: \$21.49.
Supplies:

- horse bean bags (1 per child)

Charley Horse's friends have escaped from their corral, and the kids need to help them find their way back home. Before the party, hide the horses around the yard or in a room. At the party, let kids loose (with adult help) to look for the horses until all of them have been rescued. Let kids know beforehand that they each get to find and keep one horse.

## Moo-sical Toy Circle

Estimated time: 30 minutes. Estimated cost for a party of 8: \$22.
Supplies:

- bag of party favors (for prizes)
- cow bean bag
- party music CD

Fill a bag with party favors, and select a cow (or horse) bean bag. Seat everyone in a circle, and put on some lively music. Players pass around the bean bag while music plays. When music stops, player holding bean bag wins a party favor and steps out of the game. Continue until everyone has won a prize.

## Cowboy Cody's Ho Down

Estimated time: 25 minutes. Estimated cost for a party of 8: \$12.

## Supplies:

- kids' cowboy music CD Put on the CD, and invite everyone to form a square dancing line that moves from room to room, in time to the music. Invite everyone to sing along, and do-si-do!



## Cowpoke Milk Shakes

Estimated time: 25 minutes. Estimated cost for a party of 8: \$14. Ingredients:

- 6 cups milk -6 tbsp. cocoa mix -3 ripe bananas (sliced)
- 4 scoops of vanilla ice cream or frozen yogurt

A yummy birthday beverage for your herd of 8 . Divide quantity of the first 3 ingredients in half. Blend. Add 2 scoops of ice cream, and whirl away some more. Next, make the second batch. Serve in our exclusive western boot cups.

## Campfire S'mores

Estimated time: 20 minutes. Estimated cost for a party of 8: \$10. Ingredients:

- chocolate chips - marshmallows - graham crackers It's easy to make these old favorites, even if you don't have a real campfire. Just use your microwave! Simply place a spoonful of chocolate chips on a graham cracker half, top with a marshmallow, and heat in microwave approximately 1 minute. (Keep on plate or paper towel.) Then put other graham cracker half on top.


## Cowboy Cody's Mini Burgers

Estimated time: 30 minutes. Estimated cost for a party of 8: \$15. Host a little barbeque by serving up tiny burgers. Ingredients:

- 2 pounds ground beef, turkey meat or veggie mix
- 4 tablespoons ketchup
- salt and pepper
- miniature hamburger buns
- tiny condiments: small squares of cheese, sweet pickles, cherry tomato slices, lettuce, etc.
Fire up the grill (or use a frying pan). With your hands, mix meat with ketchup. Add a dash of salt and pepper. Roll into 16 balls (for 16 burgers), and press to form patties that are about a half-inch thick. Grill each side for about 5-7 minutes. Invite everyone to top burgers with tiny condiments.
